

NOV. 2008 ART WALK

Follow the MAP:

1. BOMBAY SAPPHIRE ART LOUNGE

Start off at the Bombay Sapphire Art Lounge, 2234 NW 2nd Ave. Grab a drink, relax, talk about art, catch up with friends, and meet new ones. Also, snag some free drink tickets to the downtown after-party at Poplife at White Room, 1306 N. Miami Ave. 7-10pm

2. DAVID CASTILLO GALLERY

Make sure to check out Glaxis Novoa's *Old / New* show at the David Castillo Gallery, 2234 NW 2nd Ave. Glaxis has been featured in MAP before and his work on marble is always a hit with us. Also, slip into the project room to encounter pieces by Jay Ore. 7-10pm

3. SPINELLO GALLERY

Then walk over to the Spinello Gallery, 2294 NW 2nd Ave., for *Letting Down*, a solo show by Miami-based artist Agustina Woodgate, her second with the gallery.

4. GALLERY DIET

Down the street, head into Gallery Diet, 174 NW 23rd St., for what promises to indeed be the highlight of this month's gallery walk: Brian Burkhardt's *bi(h)ome*, a geodesic dome, featuring an array of mutant insects that he has fabricated. 7-10pm

5. FREDRIC SNITZER GALLERY

If you haven't seen it yet, here's another chance to catch the much-anticipated solo show by painter Hernan Bas at the Fredric Snitzer Gallery, 2247 NW 1st Place. Bas is one of the most well-known and successful artists to emerge from Miami, and deservedly so. 7-10pm

6. DORSCH GALLERY

Make a stop at the Dorsch Gallery for the closing reception of *A Stone's Throw*, where artist Mark Koven has covered the spacious gallery with 21 tons of sand and invites viewers to make their own stones and skip them across the gallery. 7-10pm

7. HAROLD GOLEN GALLERY

Next, hit up the Harold Golen Gallery, 314 NW 24th St., for *The Cosmic Glob Show*, an eye-popping exhibit of paintings by KRK Ryden. 7-11pm

8. GALERIE EMMANUEL PERROTIN

Drive up to the Galerie Emmanuel Perrotin, 174 NW 30th St., for Daniel Arsham's excellent solo show, *The Undoing*, featuring new paintings and sculptures jutting from the gallery walls, and KAWS' *Saturated*, an exhibition of large-scale paintings inspired by SpongeBob and the Smurfs. 7-10pm

9. DAMIEN B. CONTEMPORARY ART CENTER

For a special treat, head over to the Damien B. Contemporary Art Center, 282 NW 36th St., for *A View of the 9th Art: The Art of Graphic Novels*, where you can view original pieces by international creators of bandes dessinées (BD), including Mohamed Aouamri, Alex Baladi, Régis Loisel, and Yves Swolfs.

10. O.H.W.O.W.

Be sure to swing by O.H.W.O.W. (Our House West of Wynwood), 3100 NW 7 Ave., for *Wreckless Abandon*, a solo exhibition of works by the prominent Rostarr. A rare opportunity to see his work in Miami. Drinks and music to cap the evening. 7pm-12am
